

Minutes of the IQAC Meeting (23/06/2017)

1. It was unanimously decided to organize NSOP with prior planning in the staff council meeting.
2. It was unanimously decided that the Bridge Course Coordinator would circulate a notice for organization of subject wise Bridge Courses.
3. In order to enhance use of ICT among students, it was unanimously decided to focus as many departments, on seminar activity, as possible.
4. Construction of compound wall and renovation of cultural room were prime among infrastructure issue. It was unanimously decided to complete the construction of compound wall and renovate the cultural room providing AV facility.
5. In order to empower students with additional learning, it was unanimously decided to design and conduct Add –on Courses in some departments.
6. With prior permission of Chair following issues were discussed.
 - Remedial Coaching
 - Feedback mechanism
 - Mentor Mentee
 - Hobby workshop
 - Earn while learn activity
 - Library enhancement

The coordinator, Mr. O. I. Thakur coordinated the meeting. With permission of the chair he declared that the meeting was concluded.

Action Taken

1. New Student orientation Programme was organized on 03 – 05 August 2017
2. Bridge Courses were organized for First Year Students during third and fourth week of July 2017.
3. Compound wall construction work completed almost with front side partially remaining.
4. Student Seminar activity was organized by Botany, Zoology, Computer Science, Physics, B. Com., Economics and Political Science Departments.
5. Add-on courses were conducted by department of Computer Science.
6. Following issues were addressed to:
 - ✓ Remedial Coaching: Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science, Physics, English, Economics and Political Science Departments conducted these classes during September 2017.
 - ✓ Feedback mechanism: Formal feedback from students was not derived.
 - ✓ Mentor Mentee : Average number of meetings per teacher : 02, Total number of meetings during the session : 54
 - ✓ Hobby workshop: 6 Day workshop on Cooking & Beauty Parlour was organised during 24th to 29th July 2017.
 - ✓ Earn while learn activity : Initial procedure to initiate earn while learn activity could be carried out
 - ✓ Library enhancement: 704 Text Books and 54 Reference Books were added in addition to enhancement in e-resources.

Minutes of the IQAC Meeting with staff Council (22/09/2017)

- IQAC members conducted meeting with Staff Council to detail about the new framework for assessment and accreditation.
- The IQAC Coordinator, Mr. O. I. Thakur gave detailed information of the new framework for assessment and accreditation.
- Groups from among teachers were formed to study each criterion.
- It was also decided that the Criterion wise groups would prepare PPTs for a workshop to be held in future so as to appreciate the new framework.
- Hon. Chairman, Dr. S. M. Bhuskute discussed the outcome of New Student Orientation Programme.

Action Taken

1. A team of 04 IQAC members had attended a National Seminar at Shivaji Mahavidyalaya, Parbhani based on the new accreditation framework. Accordingly the same was detailed to the staff council.
2. For more detailed study criterion wise groups were formed. Groups prepared PPTs for workshop.
3. Workshop could not be organized.
4. The outcome of NSOP was discussed so as to fine tune it for the next session.
